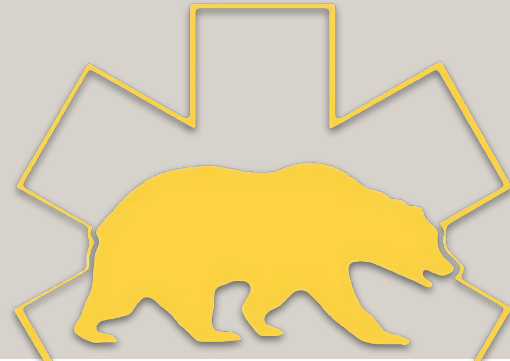

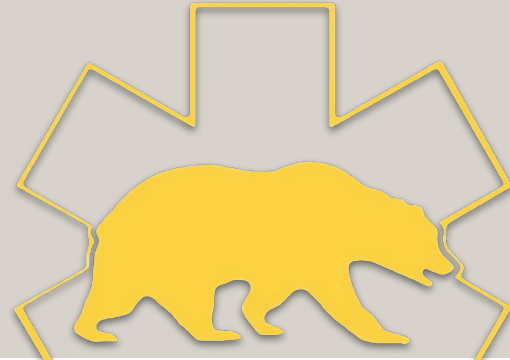

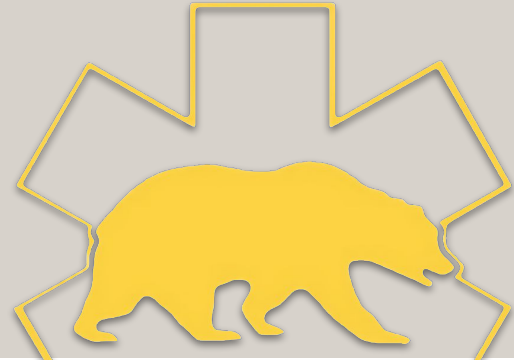


# WHAT IS A MEDICAL RESERVE CORPS?

  - Other Major Events



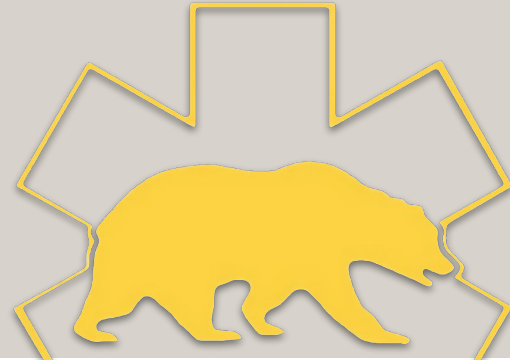


# PUBLIC HEALTH PROGRAMS

- **AHA CPR Program**
  - Low cost BLS and Heartsaver courses and certifications to UC Berkeley and the surrounding community
- **Stop the Bleed**

- Medicine should be demystified, non-judgemental, and humane

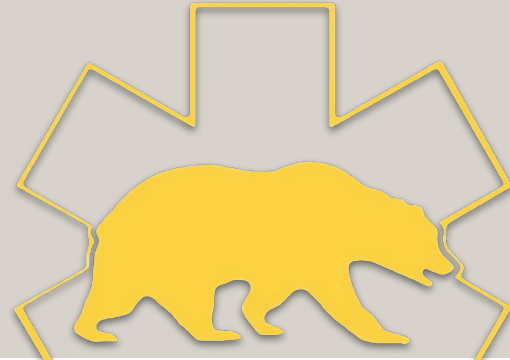

  - BLS/CPR for Healthcare Providers card
  - NREMT or CA EMT card
    - You MUST obtain your CA EMT in the same semester of application
  - ICS 100b and 700a
    - Free, found on FEMA website (FEMA → Independent Study → ICS [100](#) and [700](#))

- Medical scenario
- Trauma scenario
- Physical Ability testing
  - Manual gurney lift x150 lbs
  - Backboard lift x130lbs
  - Continuous chest compressions for 2 minutes
